## 9. Matters Arising:

a. <u>Dog Control Order</u>: Clerk to ask the Dog Warden to visit as there are several dogs off lead. Article to be put in the Parish magazine reminding people of the dog control order

- **c.** <u>**Trees on Recreation Ground**</u>: Continue to monitor the trees, including the large trees on the dog walk and by the pond.
- d. <u>Under 7s Play Area</u>. The equipment in good order

## e. Play Equipment

Some of the small wooden posts around the edge of the apparatus had been pulled out. Joel will replace these during the winter. **Action: JA** It was reported that the large climbing frame and the top of the swings will need repainting shortly. Continue to monitor

- f. <u>Seats/ Bench by Magic Dragon Nursery</u>: Treatment to some of the seats. The bench by the Magic Dragon needs rubbing down and revarnishing **Action: JA**
- g. <u>Allotments</u>: Consider any work on allotments with the budget ie provision of edging boards and replacing the hedging at the bottom of the allotments. Cllr Gould with liaise with Bronwen Walton Action: SG
- h. <u>Play Surface</u>: Continue to monitor
- i. <u>Removal of brushwood</u>: It is <u>recommended</u> that the quotation from Tree Parts Ltd to chip and remove the brushwood in the sum of £280+ vat be accepted
- I. <u>See-saw</u>: Joel to paint this shortly. Acton: JA
- **m.** Irrigation system: New 6' x 8' shed to be ordered. Total cost with erection bearers etc is £875. Waterscape Solutions will drain down and remove the irrigation system. ES Electrical will remove the electrics. Once the shed has been delivered and erected the irrigation system will be reinstalled and the electrics reconnected. The issue of a small amount of water from the pump spilling onto the floor when this is drained was discussed and it was agreed that as this was only once a year it was not a problem. If necessary a small hole could be made in the floor of the shed to allow drainage.
- **n.** <u>**Picnic table**</u>: There are still studs in the ground. Joel to bind these and put tape round. Quotation for a replacement received in the sum of £494. This will be purchased if there is money in the budget.
- **Bowling Green digging bees**: Cllr Whitford had prepared a report which had been discussed by the Full Council. The Committee will look at this again in the Spring.
- p. <u>Marking of tennis courts for tennis and netball</u>: It is <u>recommended</u> that the quotation from Niall Newport in the sum of £600 to reinstate the lines on both tennis courts and to mark out netball court on the lower court be accepted.
- **q.** <u>White Bedford van on Car Park</u>: Clerk to ask for this to be removed by the end of the month. Action Clerk

## 10. Lovar Water Garden:

The installation of new steps had been completed. Cllr Clench to ask Kevin Ford to put small caps on the top of the posts. Action: AC

#### Replacement bridge

Notification received from Wiltshire Planning Department that planning permission would not be required to replace the bridge with a similar one

It was agreed to discuss future work on the bridge with the budget, including money for drawing up working plans (approximately £1500). Cllr Clench will pursue this and will speak to the Environment Agency re a culvert

#### Action: AC

As well as replacing the bridge the steps on the other side of the river would need replacing.
